ACADEMIC INFORMATION

Academic policy

The academic goal of the school is to educate students in such a way that the intellect, the emotion and the spirit are enlightened, not giving way to mediocrity or parochialism. Student should be able to translate theories taught in the classroom to reality, through their lives and ministries.

PROGRAMMES

The following are programs run by the School:

CHILDREN SPECIAL (CHILDREN BIBLE SCHOOL)

This is a Six-month intensive course designed for the Children on Saturdays with a view to giving them a thorough biblical orientation and guiding them through social and personal problems that is associated with their stage of growth.

Admission Requirements

In the Christian way and should be able to communicate in English
CHILDREN are awarded Certificate at the completion of the program.

WORLD CHRISTIAN UNIVERSITY

This is a Special intensive course designed for Christians who desire sustainable spiritual growth, effective Christian living, and a fruit fulminatory in the body of Christ, for all levels of Pastors, Evangelist, Prophet, and all upcoming ministers of the gospel

To meet the demand of our time for Christian education, the school runs the following special Programs:

- i. Mission Week,
- ii. Prayer Conference,
- iii. Minister Conference,
- iv. Seminars,
- v. Practical Week,
- vi. Graduation,

Students are awarded Certificate in any of this special program at the completion of the program.

CERTIFICATE

This program is designed for pastors, Christian workers, and those intending to enter full – time Christian services, to equip the students with knowledge of fundamental Christian doctrines, and with practical ministerial/theological exposure necessary to enhance their ministry. The program is an equivalent of part one diploma program, and it runs for minimum of 8 calendar months which is divided into 2 trimesters
Students can major in Prophetic, Missions, Christian education, and Biblical theology.

Admission Requirements

Candidates must have at least four passes in GCE O/level subjects its equivalents. However, those who have attempted secondary school education may be considered for a provisional admission.

Admission Requirements

Candidates must have at least 3 credits and 2 passes in GCE or SSCE O/ level subjects, or its equivalents, in addition to completion of certificate program

BACHELOR'S DEGREE

This program is designed for pastors, Christian workers, and those intending to enter full – time Christian service, who desire to further Ministerial, Biblical and Theological education to a higher level.

It runs for a minimum of 8 calendar months which is divided into 2 trimesters, and students can major in Prophetic, Counselling, Leadership, Missions, Theology, Christian Education, Biblical counseling, Biblical Theology, or Christian Ministries.

Admission Requirements

Candidates who passes a diploma from (WOCUN) or its equivalent from a credible Bible School, as well as passes in GCE or SSCE O/Level subjects, may be offered admission into the Bachelor Degree program

MASTER DEGREE

This program is designed for pastors and Christian workers who have a desire to acquire Master in a specific field of ministerial or Theological study and also for those who may wish to pursue their educational aspiration up to the doctorate level

Its runs for minimum of 8 calendar months which is divided into 2 trimesters, and students can major in Leadership, Missions, Theology, Christian Education, Biblical counseling, Biblical Theology, Christian Ministries or Biblical Law

DOCTORAL DEGREE

One with master's Degree from this institution or any Government approved Theological College/seminary/institute or University accredited by Local/International accrediting bodies is eligible to apply. The applicants must present testimonials, Transcripts and Certificates of all Schools attended before admission

It runs for 12calendar months, of academic work/research & writing of dissertation. And Majors on Theology, Christian Leadership, Christian Education and Ethics, Christian Management/Administration, Missiology/Communication and Divinity

ADMISSION REQUIREMENT

Candidates must possess a Bachelor's degree and a post-graduate diploma obtained from the institution or its equivalents from a credible bible school to be offered admission into the master's degree program.

In addition candidates must have credits WASC/SSCE, O Level GCE its equivalent. The applicant before admission must present testimonials, transcripts and certificates of schools attended

ADMINISTRATIVE STRUCTURE

Board of regents

This is the highest administrative body of the institute chaired by the Vice Chancellor of the University, Professor E. Pius ... other members comprise those who are vested with the trusteeship of the University.

Management committee

This committee is headed by the Sole Supervisor of the University in any nation the School is planted who is appointed by the board of Regents. They see to the day-to-day running of the University. Other members are as follows: Sole Administrator, Administrator, Dean of Studies, Dean of Students' Affairs (DSA), the Registrar/bursar, Graduation Director and the heads of departments who are responsible for the supervision of academic activities of the different department of the University.

Academic staff

These are lectures that are responsible for teaching the students. They are equally responsible for the management of their respective courses. The academic staffs are experienced in Christian Studies and are Graduate poised to teach the total counsel of God without fear or favour

Nonacademic staff

At World Christian University (WOCUN)) a set of staff are charged with the responsibilities of come duties that compliment learning and academic activities. They include staff such as Typists, Librarian, cleaner, Driver, security-men, Technicians etc.

Students' union executive council (SEC)

It is the objective of World Christian University (WOCUN) to produce students who are well disciplined and responsible. To this effect, the institute allows students to form a union, so as to manage their own affairs and also be able to channel their views properly to the management of the University. The Dean of Students' Affairs (DSA) oversees the students union Executive Council (SEC)

Students' representative assembly (SRA)

The students' community is divided into so many constituencies for effective representation at the students' representative assembly. The assembly is meant to manage grassroots affairs of the students which the students' union Executive Council may not be involved with. They also act as pressure group to the executive council of their students

Class officials, regular including weekend session and other special session constitute the membership of this assembly
